Architectural photography exhibition exploring the concept of Emptiness

'Going through impressions in the form of personal notes, one examines and classifies some of the key images of a lifetime, the setting registered by memory, the sensory perceptions that arouse a most sensitive past. Travels, cities, and spaces are visualized from the need of remembrance, and the defence of the individuality of experience. An anonymous person uses photography as a means of expression, and manages concepts such as emptiness and colour in an attempt to face self-knowledge and the understanding of the surroundings environment.'

SCAN (Spanish Contemporary Art Network) is pleased to announce the first of a series of exhibitions in London this summer: **K: emptiness**, featuring photographs by creative team **_Marina_Morón**. The displayed works are a selection from their most recent book of the same title. Visualizing silence and solitude through **architectural photographs**, the works are structured in evocatively titled sections (*Eclairage, Instant South, She is asleep...*) exploring themes of light, colour and place. This collection of minimalist photographs can be interpreted as a visual diary of a fictional subject exploring her surroundings, memories and rooms.

_Marina_Morón is the creative team of **Jesús Marina**, professor in Granada University, and **Elena Morón**, architect and researcher, whose work explores tangible connections between the image and architectonic space with an emphasis on the experiential qualities of colour and the concept of emptiness.
